



Books give away to raise awareness about gender equality (while also raising awareness on SEA-EU alliance !)

Since last year, UBO SEA-EU team set up to international days to raise awareness about gender equality (in a broad sense).

On 8th march and 25th November, in partnership with the local unit we organize a free stand to offer books (all types: novels, comics, essays.....) related to gender equality / written by women.

Books are ordered to a local bookshop. We take advice from UBO librarians, staff involved in gender equality questions, SEA-EU partners for the SEA-EU selection.

The stand is in the entrance of the university library, just in front of the door. The activity takes 2 hours (or until all the books are gone....)

- ➔ Possibility to engage university stakeholders active on the question (at UBO, we are joined by the sexual harassment unit)
- ➔ There is a budget, but...
 - It can be adjusted depending on how much books you would like to offer
 - If you stick a sticker on the book with SEA-EU and Erasmus logo, it can be eligible on dissemination cost (contact your local office!) and it makes more sense to offer books than goodies (in our opinion)
- ➔ While students are looking at the books, you can deliver your speech! (about SEA-EU, about gender equality....)
- ➔ It is also a good way to promote the cultural diversity of the alliance, if you do a SEA-EU selection.

SEA-EU books selection (8th march 2023). Total nb of books ordered: 120, dispatched between 3 libraries on the campus (3 stands)
