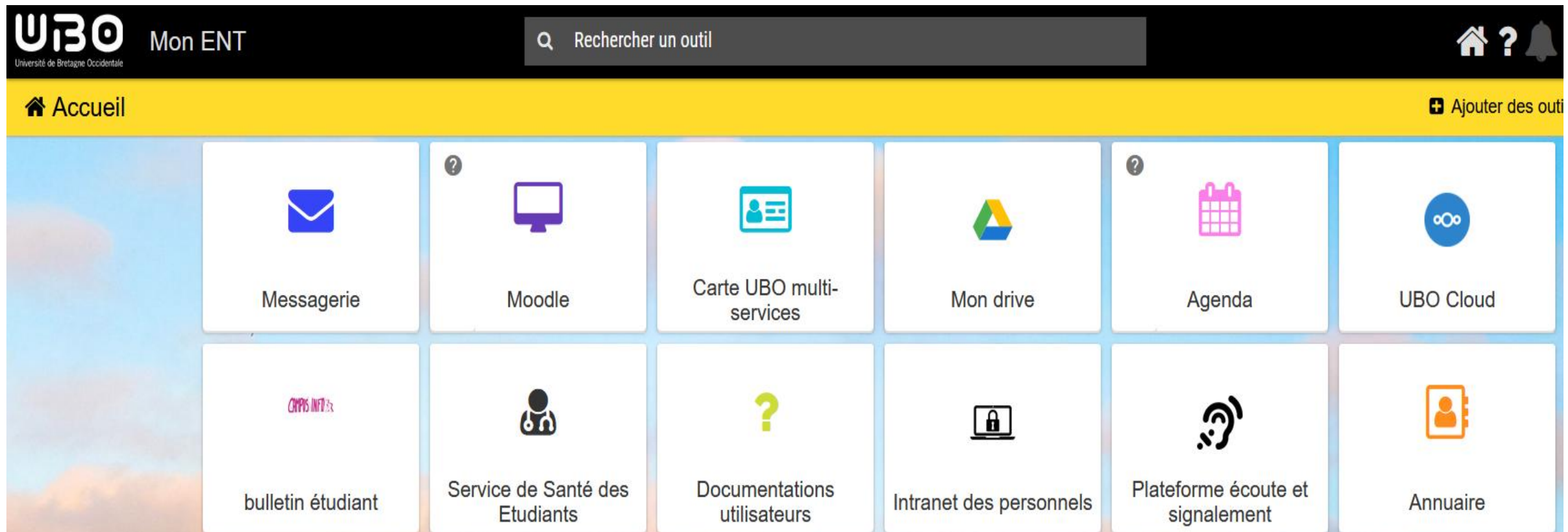

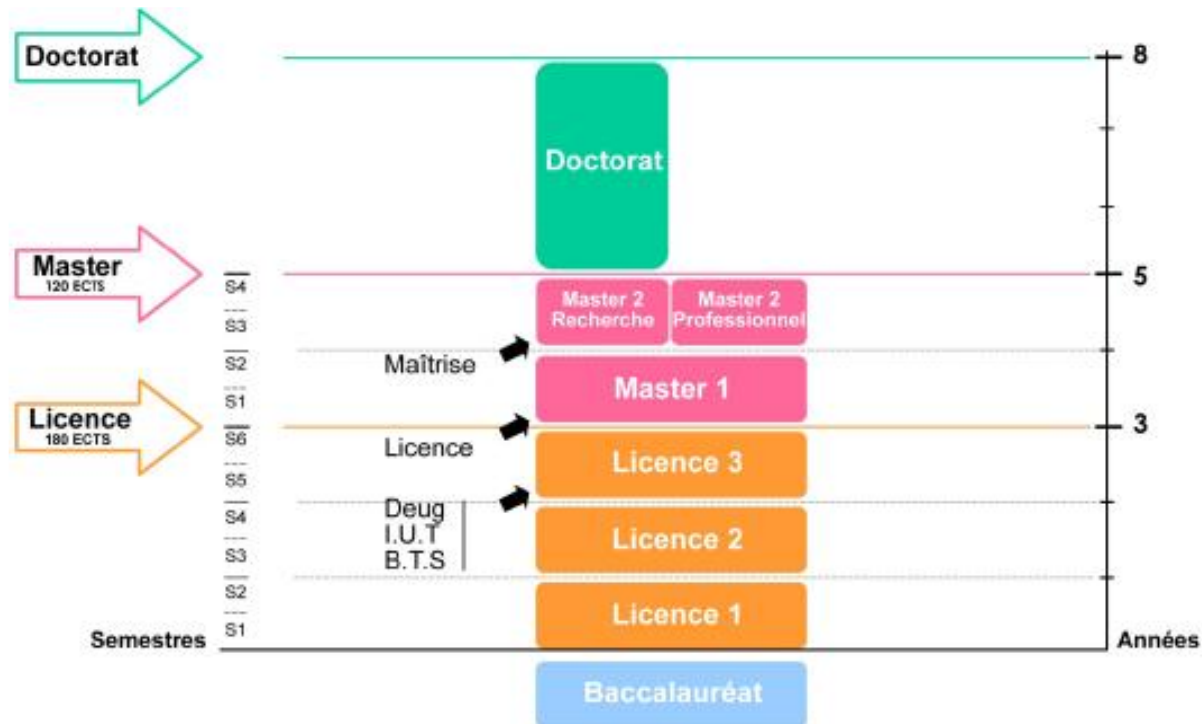

What's the LMD system ?



How to register for classes? For Erasmus and exchange students only

- Introduce yourself to each professor for each first class
- The Learning Agreement, to complete with the responsible professor in your Faculty

A few practical information

- **Semesters:** autumn term : S2, S4, S6 / spring term : S1, S3, S5
- **Licence and Master :** L1, L2, L3, M1, M2
- **Type of classes :** TD : travaux dirigés (in a small classroom, with a small group / CM : Cours magistraux (in amphitheatres, with a big group)
- **Exams :** contrôle continu (CC) : several exams during the whole semester/ contrôle terminal (CT) : one final exam
- **Courses :** BCC : Bloc de compétences (grouping of several UEs) / UE : Unités d'enseignements (one or several classes). One UE = X ECTS credits



Languages and sports

Pôle Langues : Conversation and exchange workshops every day between 12:30 and 13:30 pm. Several languages are offered (English, Spanish, Italian, Arabic, FLE, Breton, etc.) You can take part in the workshops or be a tutor yourself and share your native language with other students.



Sports (SUAPS) : possibility of taking sports courses (only 1 can give ECTS credits). The list of courses and registration will be available when you have access to the ENT (digital workspace).

- Erasmus or exchange students: Contact your educational coordinator in your department/faculty. This is the person who signed your Learning Agreement.
- Students under agreement: contact your referent teacher or your school secretariat.

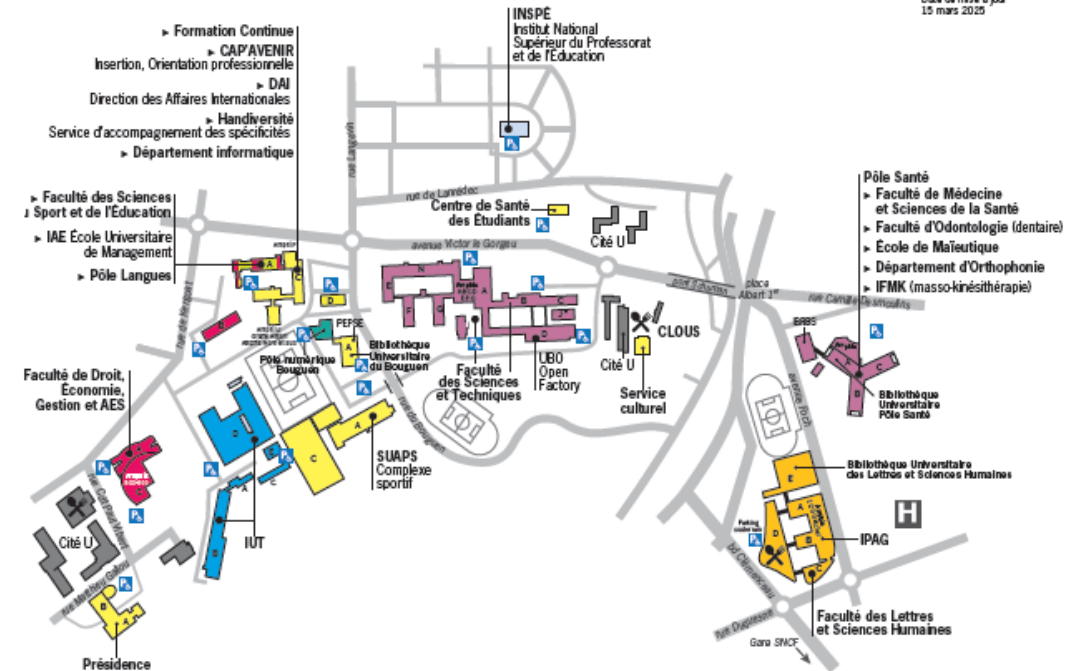
